	Applicants should submit three letters of recommendation on the forms proved in this
	packet, to the Coordinator of Graduate Student Services, in GRAD 116B.
	Recommendations should be from former instructors, employers or other professionals in
	your community.
	Provide a statement of your professional goals to the Coordinator of Graduate Student
	Services, GRAD 116B.
	Provide a writing sample (see guidelines) to the Coordinator of Graduate Student Services,
	116B.
	An interview with the Counselor Education faculty is required.
